## TODAY'S EPIC STORY: GOD CONFIRMS HIS PROMISE

GENESIS 18:1-19;  
21:1-7

### THE STORY @ HOME

In the Epic story that we learned today, the Lord visits Abraham in the form of three men. Abraham recognizes the Lord and provides food and drink so the Lord will stay for a while and not pass by. The Lord said that Abraham's wife Sarah would have a child by this time next year, but Sarah overheard and laughed. The Lord said, "Is anything too hard for the Lord?" Very shortly after this, Sarah did become pregnant and gave birth to a baby boy named Isaac.

#### PARENTS & KIDS QUESTIONS:

- Why did Sarah laugh? What would you have done if you were Sarah and someone said you were going to have a child when you were 90 years old?
- What do you think... Is anything too hard for the Lord, like Genesis 18:14 asks?
- What does it mean to find favor in the eyes of the Lord? Do you find favor in the eyes of the Lord? Are there things you do or say that are not pleasing to God?
- What is the most amazing thing God has done in your life or the life of your family?

### TOGETHER @ HOME

Play babies. At 90 years old, Sarah finally gets the child she has been longing for. Act out how she might care for her precious son, Isaac. Express joy and laughter like Sarah might have done.

### BIBLE MEMORY @ HOME

"Blessed is the one who trusts in the LORD, whose confidence is in him." (Jeremiah 17:7)

Hit a balloon or light weight ball back and forth to each other. When the balloon or ball drops to the ground, have the person who let it fall say the verse, or say the verse all together before starting again.
