## TODAY'S EPIC STORY: DAVID'S SIN 2 SAMUEL 11–12

### THE STORY @ HOME

King David saw Bathsheba, the wife of Uriah the Hittite, and thought she was very beautiful. He brought her to his house and slept with her. When Bathsheba sent word that she was pregnant, David had Uriah killed and married Bathsheba. This made the Lord very angry. David repented and asked God for forgiveness, but there were still consequences. The baby that Bathsheba had given birth to became very sick and died.

#### PARENTS & KIDS QUESTIONS:

- What causes us to sin? Did David have to sin, or did he choose to sin?
- What did David do when the prophet Nathan told David that he had displeased God? How do you think David felt? How do you think God felt?
- Has anyone told you that you've done something wrong? How should we respond when we find out we've sinned, or disobeyed God?
- Why are there consequences to our actions even when we ask for forgiveness?

### TOGETHER @ HOME

Write a letter using pictures or words to apologize to God for something you've done to disobey Him. Ask for God's forgiveness. Do you need to apologize to someone else too? If so write an apology letter to that person as well.
