TODAY'S BIBLE STORY: PENTECOST ACTS 2:1-41

THE STORY HOME

What power! Acts 2:1-41 tells us that all the disciples were together when suddenly a thunderous blowing sound settled down on them filling them with the power of the Holy Spirit. People from around the world had gathered too and they heard the sound. They were puzzled. Each disciple started talking in a different world language so everyone understood. Peter spoke to the crowd retelling the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus. When they heard him, they were moved in their hearts. “What do we do?” they asked. Peter answered, “Repent and be baptized for the forgiveness of sins.” And then he promised that Jesus would be with them and they would receive the gift of the Holy Spirit, too.

- Do you think God can hear someone pray in the language of an African, South American or Frenchman? What about someone from the U.S.A. or Mexico? Why?
- I wonder if God hears you pray in your language and also hears someone from another area of the world praying at the same time.

Fan fun. Using a small fan, blow on a variety of objects to see the effects. Blow cotton balls across the table. Try blowing leaves or drinking straws. Take turns laying different objects on the table to witness the power of the wind generated by the fan.
