## TODAY'S EPIC STORY: ADAM AND EVE

GENESIS 2:15-23; 3

### THE STORY @ HOME

Today's Epic story was about how God created Adam and Eve and walked with them every day. However, Adam and Eve disobeyed God by eating from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil in the middle of the garden. God loved Adam and Eve, but they could no longer live in the garden as they had before, so God punished them and sent them out.

#### PARENTS & KIDS QUESTIONS:

- What did Adam and Eve do to disobey God? How have you disobeyed God?
- What were God's punishments for Adam and Eve?  
Why do you think God chose those punishments?
- God loved and cared for Adam and Eve, even though they had to be punished for their sins. Check out Genesis 3:21. What did God do to care for them?
- How do you think Adam and Eve felt when God sent them out of the garden? How do you think God felt when He sent Adam and Eve out of the garden?

### TOGETHER @ HOME

Have the family go outside. Find some weeds in your vegetable garden, flower garden, lawn, or sidewalk cracks. Pull them together. God said to Adam, *"Cursed is the ground because of you; through painful toil you will eat food from it all the days of your life. It will produce thorns and thistles for you, and you will eat the plants of the field."* Talk about why sin makes life more painful and difficult.

### BIBLE MEMORY @ HOME

"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth," (*Genesis 1:1*).

With 3 or more people, form a circle. If there are only two people, sit across from each other. Have the first person say, "In." The second participant says, "the." Then, have each participant take turns saying the remainder of the words in the verse. Say, "Genesis 1:1" together. Repeat, attempting to say the verse faster and faster.
